GRP is a UK-registered charity selecting and assessing the world's highest impact climate mitigation charities – *for you.*

- Proprietary selection/assessment methodology
- Diverse portfolio of best-in-class climate charities
- Overseen by leading environmental scientists and GRP Trustees
- Methodology guides re-assessments every six months
- 'Underperforming' charities removed and replaced

WHAT IS THE GLOBAL RETURNS PROJECT?

HOW IT WORKS



- Donations go directly to your selected charities, *with no deductions*
- **GRP operating costs funded separately** (by Trustees and charitable trusts, foundations and individuals)
- **Exclusive impact reports** every six months
- **Access to GRP expertise and events**

HOW IT WORKS

1. Select charities

2. Donate to GRP

GRP distributes to selected charities **with no deductions**

Donation can be one-off, regular, or part of overall asset allocation approach. GRP often coordinates with wealth managers.

GRP typically provides unrestricted funding

3. Receive impact reports

Exclusive reporting every six months (personalised annually)

4. Get involved

Access to GRP events, expertise, underlying charities

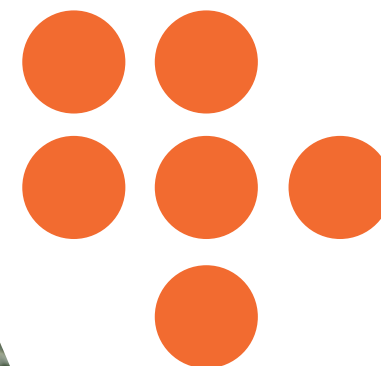

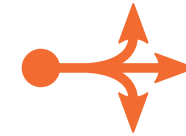
